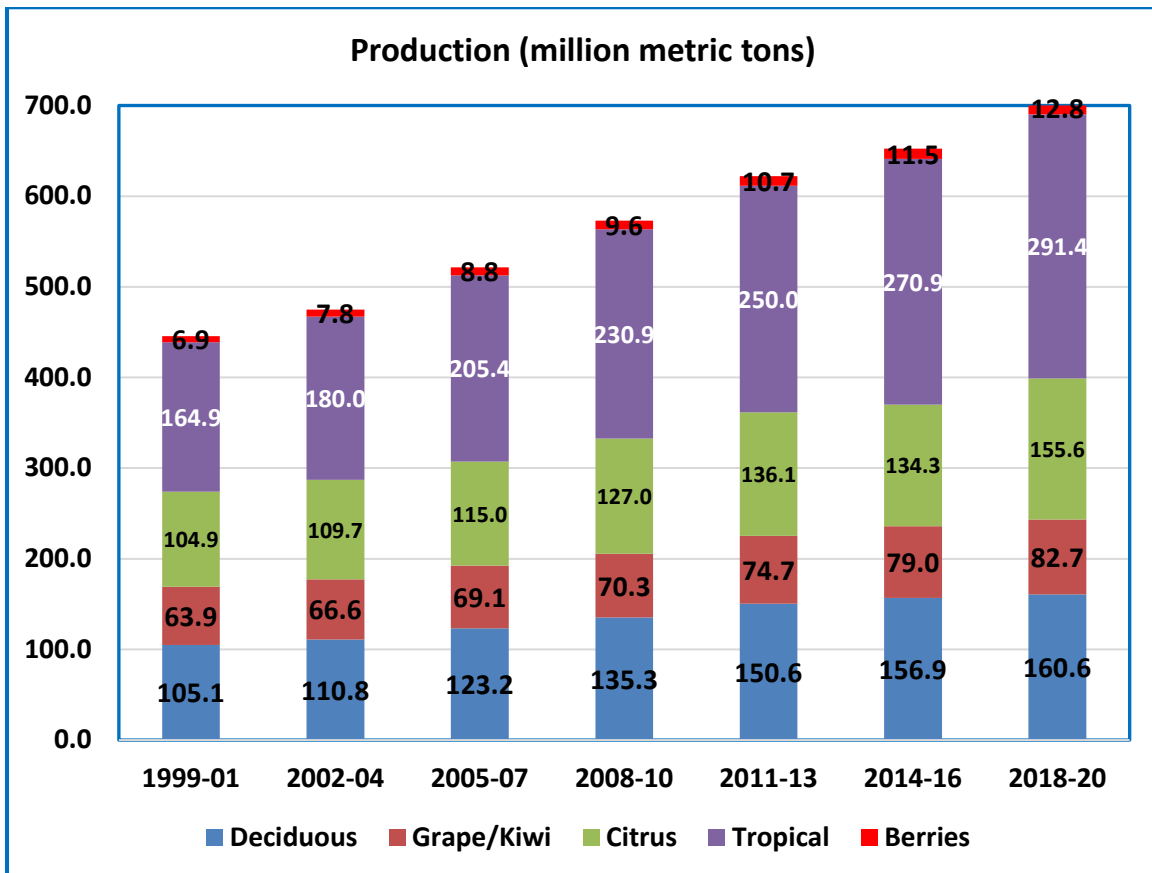


World Production of Major Fruit Categories 1999-01 to 2018-20

Comment: This chart shows how the world production of each major fruit category and of all fruits and berries has risen in each three-year period between 1999-01 and 2018-20. Overall world fruit production increased by almost 58 percent, while that of deciduous fruits increased by 53 percent. This compares with an increase in world population of 26 percent, meaning that world per capita fruit supplies increased by over 25 percent. The biggest volume increase was for tropical fruits, while the biggest percentage increase was for berries. Apples accounted for almost 54 percent of all deciduous fruit in 2018-2020. Pears and peaches/nectarines each accounted for about 15 percent of deciduous fruits. Apples were a distant second to bananas and substantially ahead of grapes and oranges as the leading individual fruits.
